KEY STANDARD CONTRACT TERMS

PLAYER ACQUISITION	Draft and player retention processes, overseas players can be contracted after the draft for a retainer of up to \$65k, replacement players can be signed directly outside of this
TEAM SALARY CAP	\$732,624K per team, minimum \$17,388k, maximum overseas player retainer \$110k
CONTRACT LENGTH	Contract Year – 12 months, 1 July to 30 June or shorter period referred to in contract schedule Competition Period 27 th October – 1 st December (5 weeks)
PAYMENT DATES	3 equal instalments on or before the 15th day of the month in October, November and December
TERMINATION RIGHT IN EVENT OF INJURY	Allowable if player is unavailable for all matches (unless otherwise specified), fee reduced pro rata based on availability as % of group stage matches, consideration for Marketing base (if any)
TERMINATION RIGHTS – OTHER	For Cause – for serious or persistent misconduct/breach of the contract

INSURANCE PROVISIONS

PRIVATE MEDICAL COVER	Player must maintain own Health Insurance for duration of the term. Employer covers excess medical for on and off field injuries
PTD FROM CRICKET COVER	In certain circumstances, players may be covered by Cricket Australia Insurance Policy. Players may also opt to receive superannuation allocations into Australian Cricket Superannuation Plan and take up available insurance within the plan
PTD FROM ANY OCCUPATION	As above
ACCIDENTAL DEATH	As above

PLAYER COMMERCIAL RIGHTS SUMMARY

STRUCTURE	Exchanged via Player Contract to team/league
APPEARANCES	11 (or 8 only where the Retainer is equal to or less than \$50,000)
USE OF IMAGE	At all times with min. 2 other players and always in team kit in capacity of a WBBL cricketer. Can use individuals' image for game promotion of game development appearances
BACK OF BAT BRANDING	Player owned, 10in2 permitted in addition to manufacturer – not conflicting with primary partner or lead competition partner
PERSONAL ENDORSEMENTS RESTRICTIONS	Cannot conflict with primary partner or lead competition partner
DATA MANAGEMENT	Extensive data management provisions in the contract to only be shared for medical, operational and performance purposes
