POSITIVE DEVELOPMENTS AND PROGRESS	
ETPL	ETPL and ICA / DCA / SCA are engaged in finalising a collective bargaining agreement and negotiated standard player contracts which contain a number of protection and benefits for players.
MLC	MLC and USCA have completed a new collective bargaining agreement and negotiated standard player contracts which contain a number of protections and benefits for players.
Bermuda Smash Invitational	BSI have proactively engaged with WCA to assess event employment conditions against best practice.
FLAGGED ISSUES	
BPL	Significant and consistent outstanding non-payment issues over multiple events. - Franchises where issues have been raised with WCA include Sylhet Strikers, Durbar Rajshahi, Chittagong Kings, Khulna Tigers. - It is recommended players / agents proceed with extreme caution and seek upfront payments.
Cayman Max60	Significant outstanding non-payment issues from 2025 event. Significant late payment issues from 2024 event. It is recommended players / agents proceed with extreme caution and seek upfront payment to any future events or those managed by the same ownership groups.
Abu Dhabi T10	Some outstanding non-payment issues from 2024 event. It is recommended players / agents proceed with extreme caution and seek upfront payments.
